REPORT OF THE COMMITTEE ON THE REVISION OF THE CURRICULUM

Submitted to the Faculty of the Department of Chemistry

The Committee on the Revision of the Curriculum of the Department of Chemistry was organized in 1952 to study the present curriculum and to recommend changes that would improve the quality of the undergraduate program. The Committee has held several public hearings and has received many suggestions from students, faculty, and other interested persons. The Committee's report is based on the results of these hearings and on its own study of the literature and of the curricula of other departments.

The Committee believes that the present curriculum is generally sound, but that it needs to be revised to meet the needs of the students and of the society. The Committee recommends that the curriculum be revised to include more courses in the physical sciences and to reduce the number of courses in the biological sciences.

The Committee also recommends that the curriculum be revised to include more courses in the social sciences and to reduce the number of courses in the humanities. The Committee believes that these changes will improve the quality of the undergraduate program and will make it more relevant to the needs of the students and of the society.
